

2025 NASHVILLE SPRING SERIES TIRE RULES

(HIGHLAND RIM & NASHVILLE FAIRGROUNDS SPEEDWAY)

LEGEND CARS AND BANDOLERO CARS

The following rules will be in place for the 2025 Nashville Spring Series.

- Dry tire rule.
- Hoosier tires legal to the 2025 INEX rulebook are required to be used for this event.
- The four tires on your car for qualifying on 4/15 will be marked and must be used for all competition during the Highland Rim portion of the Nashville Spring Series.
- The four tires on your car for qualifying on 4/18 will be marked and must be used for all competition during the Nashville Fairgrounds portion of the Nashville Spring Series.
- Marked tires and un-marked (INEX legal) tires can be used during practice rounds.
- You can use your marked tires in any combination on your car (tires can be moved around the car for stagger, wear).
- Tires that INEX determines have been altered physically or chemically will be confiscated & that car, driver & crew chief will be disqualified, removed from the event & face possible INEX suspension.
- The INEX marked tires are the mandatory (and only) tires permitted to be used for qualifying and the main events.
- Buffing, cutting, heating, washing, etc. of the tire in the pits is not permitted.
- Chemicals are not permitted on the tires.
- In the rare occurrence that a competitor needs to change a tire (crash damage, flat, etc.), That must be approved by INEX.
- If a competitor purposefully flattens marked tires for the purpose of getting a new tire, that competitor will be penalized by INEX.
- Tires can be brought from home / purchased from your local dealer.
- **Tire grinders, tire rotisseries or any machines designed to buff, grind, wash or prep. tires are not allowed in the pit area or on the racetrack property. If found on property, this equipment will be confiscated.**
